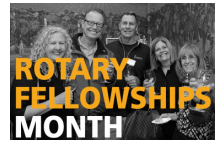

Kickin' it in Italy – Summer 2019

Lily Beineke described for us the fun trip to Italy (actually the newest European nation, not being unified until 1861) she took with her mom just before she was 21. During her exploits (n Venice, Rome, Vatican City, and Pompeii) she had surprising discoveries including these: • Italians use *guanciale* (fatty pork mixture, with salt and herbs), not actual bacon in their *Carbonara*. • Rome has many mysterious structures, such as some she saw at the *Borghese Garden*. • It seems odd that it's illegal for anyone to sit on the *Spanish Steps*. • There's a *Hard Rock Café* in Rome! • Stone streets in Pompeii have some fairly deep grooves cut by wagon wheels.
