LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM

Mr. Jeff Stahla, Public Information Officer for the Northern



Colorado Water Conservancy District, spoke to us on the huge public works project that's right in our backyard - the Chimney Hollow Dam and Reservoir. Here is how the water district describes the project:

As Northern Colorado's growth continues... the region will need collaborative storage projects that not only help us meet future water demands, but also protect the environment and wildlife, create new recreational opportunities, help maintain local food production, and preserve the region's quality of life... Those are the objectives of Chimney Hollow Reservoir Project, which is the main component of the overall Windy Gap Firming Project.

As a collaborative project between 9 municipalities, 2 water districts, and a power provider, Chimney Hollow Reservoir will be located just west of Carter Lake in southern Larimer County. When built, the reservoir will store 90,000 acrefeet of water... and provide 30,000 acre-feet annually.
