MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE:

Gail Daugherty provided a brief summary of the activities of the Membership Committee. The focus is bringing in new members, developing opportunities to represent the club in travel, and recognizing milestones and challenges in members lives. A few more members are desired.

PROGRAM:

Scoot Childers introduced speaker Dr. Bob Meroney, who talked about Secret Messages in Corporate Logos. Logos are graphic marks or emblems used by organizations (or individuals) to aid and promote instant public recognition. A cattle brand would be an example. The oldest forms include cylinder seals dating to 230 BCE, coins, coats of arms, watermarks, and silver hallmarks. Often the "secret messages" are in the use of the white space. As an example, note the arros between the E and the X. The Amazon symbol looks like it has a "smiley face" arrow below the letters, but on second look you can see that it goes from A to Z (which is the range of things that Amazon sells!)
