Dixie Schmatz gave a report about the board meeting. We accepted an application for the Berthoud Satellite Club. She also confirmed the 100th celebration is April 23, 2021. Ron Schlattman announced that the Community Grants Committee awarded grants to Sleep in Heavenly Peace, the Rotary Foundation Covid Relief Fund and helping to build a school in Nepal.

Jerry Westbrook talked to the club about how tomorrow is a big day in the history of the club, we received our charter at the Lovelander Hotel with 17 members and 96 people present at the meeting **Julie Johnson-Haffner** announced that Covid Relief funds are going out into the community and they are considering 4 applications currently. Some groups that are requesting funds are also requesting volunteers or donations of items and the committee will let the club know if anyone is interested in volunteering or helping directly.

PROGRAM

Bob Eatman introduced Colonel Tim Childress who is the commander of the Air Force ROTC Detachment at CSU and a professor of Aerospace Studies. Colonel Childress talked to the club about ROTC, Covid impacts to the military and about Memorial Day. ROTC is one of the ways you can become an officer in the US Military and is the largest source for officers. The military is responding to the pandemic by adapting how they are doing things including some restrictions on activities. Part of the success of the military's response so far is due to the flexibility of the leaders that was granted by the secretary of defense and the ability to adapt locally to conditions. Colonel Childress also discussed Memorial Day and the importance of remembering those who served and gave the ultimate sacrifice.
