"Loveland Pulse Update" by our own **John Fogle**, Loveland City Council (District III) and Lindsey



Johansen, Loveland Pulse Communications & Marketing Manager included these highlights:

- Always remember no tax dollars fund Pulse, the City of Loveland's new 100% fiber broadband service.
- Thus far, Pulse has a 25% take-rate, and not one new customer has complained about the service.
- Pulse's upload and download speeds are superior; other carriers typically deliver lower upload speeds.
- With a budget of \$95.4 M dollars, this is the largest ever capital construction project by the city.
- It will take 3-4 years (2019-2023) to completely build-out the entire system.
- THREE IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW: (1) No baloney, (2) No contracts, and (3) you'll be supporting your community, neighbors, and city's job base!
