## LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM

**“The Flying Thunderbirds - USAF”**

Supported by his spouse, Heidi, Commander **Loren “Skip” Johnson** shared his story of growing up in northeastern Colorado and becoming a member of the Air Force Thunderbirds. Commander Johnson’s life path has taken him from serving as Headquarters



Commander for General Petraeus in Afghanistan, to Commander of Buckley Air Force Base, to a 25-year career for United Airlines - all while raising a family of three girls with Heidi.

Commander Johnson spoke of a closeness he feels to Rotary because of what he describes as a similarity in the core values of Rotary - the Four-Way Test - and the core values of the Air Force. He shared a heartfelt story of visiting a 13-year old cancer patient by the name of Andy at the Hasbro Children’s Hospital following a Thunderbird flight. He felt this was his “Tap on the Shoulder”, made famous by Winston Churchill to step up when called. Saying, “no matter who you are, you can make a difference” when tapped on the shoulder. A calling he has now labeled “Andy’s Law”.
