John Stewart introduced John Paul Hansen who is his nephew and a veteran. His military career has spanned 27 years in the Air Force, Navy and Marines. He is now I of 24 antiterrorism specialists in the Navy who study and work to prevent terrorist attacks. Paul does teach classes as well as working as a specialist and discussed his experiences combatting terrorism. Paul got started in the Air Force as a crypto-tech then his unit was decommissioned between the Gulf Wars he joined the Marines and started off with law enforcement and guarded the President's helicopter. After a running accident he began to work with the physical security and anti-terrorism group. Paul shared many remarkable stories about how he worked with the anti-terrorist groups.
