LAST WEEK’S PROGRAM

Claire Bouchard of Community Foundation of No-Co shared their comprehensive report (“2024 Northern Colorado Intersections”) on our region’s most pressing challenges. The findings related to the 6 facets of well-being (chart to right) included these:



1. NOURISHING: 30% of CO’s agriculture production is from Northern

Colorado, yet agricultural land is decreasing.

2. SHELTERING & CARING: Many local renters, homeowners are living above their means, in terms of what they spend on housing (>30%).

3. TRANSACTING: NoCo has 67,000 incoming and 120,000 outgoing commuters.

4. BEAUTIFYING: We have 340 businesses in Arts, Entertainment, and Recreation sector in NoCo.

5. CONNECTING: NoCo has higher than avg poor mental health days and suicide rate.

6. RENEWING: NoCo has high civic engagement.
