Brian Nienhaus (A Retrospective): Past Pres. Brian summed up the outcome of the SHOW 2021 Governor's Art Show & Sale with the following statistics:

- ♦ Total show attendance: 2,404 (from 49 Colorado cities, 30 different states, and 2 foreign countries)
- ♦ Philanthropy impact of show estimated at: \$59,466
- ◆ Out of total net profit (more than \$36,000):
 - ♦ Thompson Education Foundation = \$12.000
 - ♦ Loveland Rotary Club = \$8,100
 - ♦ Thompson Valley Rotary Club = \$16,200
