Dwight Brummet thanked the club for the opportunity to serve as president even with the uncertainty and changes due to Covid-19.

Dave Mills updated the club on the Covid Relief Fund so far there are 34 donor Rotarians matched \$44,220 and \$44,000 has been awarded. They are still taking donations and awardees will be announced next week.

Jim Epstein provided a polio update - 3700 staff have been reassigned from Polio to Covid-19 crisis. This is making polio eradication efforts more difficult but there is more research going into vaccines.
