Tim Sendelbach told of
exciting news - transition
of the operational control
of the Alexander Mtn Fire
back to local agencies. He
accepted our standing
ovation for "the boots on
the ground" - our heroes!

Tim Sendelbach (*Fire Fighting Details*): Fire Chief
Tim's status update on the Alexander Mountain Fire
included the following remarks:

"When I stand here and say (our fire response) was a great success, I don't lose sight of the 26 families... the loss of their homes... and losing the Cow Camp structure [at Sylvan Dale Ranch]... This success was about relationships... cooperation and collaboration among multiple entities coming together... the good Lord looking out for us and having very, very calm weather! This was a slow moving fire, but it ultimately took almost 10,000 acres and 26 homes in the process... we had over 600 people operating on that fire - a remarkable deployment! ... a number of elected officials came here... I was with Joe Neguse for almost four hours... Ladies and gentlemen, there was no smoke in the air, no cameras... he came back three times. Joe Neguse made it personal, and I think it's important that you realize that... I'm not trying to get overly political..."

Carol Stark (*Recognition*): **Ron Weinberg** earned his
Paul Harris Fellow certificate and pin. Yeah, Ron!

Gary Camp (*Fire Relief*): All members were encour-
aged to give generously in response to the sometimes
funny "Enforcer" rules for penalties and call for "Happy
Dollars." The goal was \$1,000 for Alexander Mountain
Fire victim families and recovery efforts. President Bob
got emotional later when he shared that we had actual-
ly raised \$2,784 in just a 1/2 hour!

Charlie Bouchard (*Big Thanks*): LRC Foundation re-
ceived a nice thank you letter from Thompson Educa-
tion Foundation: "Thank you for elevating TEF's Resiliency
Fund for Unhoused Youth through your donation of
\$23,500 in proceeds from the Governor's Art Show."
