fold mission of the department: ① **vehicle licensing**, ② maintaining **county records**, and ③ the governance of **local elections**. Here are some highlights: • There are many options for vehicle licensing including *online services* and *self-service kiosks* at local stores. • A great new service is our *Recording Activity Notification*, where we notify you of any document with your name that has been recorded. • Currently the office needs 800 more election judges for the November elections. • All citizens are encouraged to use the drop boxes to return their ballots rather than the USPS (it helps maintain *chain of custody*). • Our election process is very tight (<1% rejected signatures and <1% spoiled ballots).
