LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM

Award-winning author Daniel Jorgensen, who is also a Rotarian and lives in Milliken, spoke on "The Process of Writing and Publishing Books." Several of his books were available for purchase at the meeting.

A native of Minnesota, Dan Jorgensen grew up on a South Dakota farm, attended a one-room country school and was the first member of his family to attend college, earning degrees in journalism and public relations from South Dakota State University with further coursework in creative writing and film at Colorado State University. A U.S. Army infantry veteran, he also is an Honor Graduate from the U.S. Defense Information School (DINFOS).

Dan has had a long career as a writer, editor, and educator, winning awards for his work in all three fields. The author of 8 books, 3 songs and a one-act play, he also has contributed to two anthologies and written hundreds of news, sports and feature stories, as both a journalist and public relations writer.
