LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM

Jeff Feneis **Executive Director** of the Loveland Housing Authority presented a program on the work and needs of his organization in promoting affordable housing the Loveland community. He discussed the requirements to qualify for rental and purchase assistance, largely helping those with an income level of 60 % or less of the area's median income, though help is available to low and moderate income residents of Loveland who already occupy their home. He discussed at length the organizations connection and cooperation, not only with the Loveland city council, but many other groups that are involved in helping those in need of housing, such as Habitat for Humanity and groups that assist homeless individuals. Several of their current housing solutions include the Meadows, Windsor Meadows, and Edge I & II, for studio, 1 bedroom and 2 bedroom units. At the end of Mr. Feneis' presentation, he entertained several questions from the audience about the workings of the program.
