PROGRAM

"Do Schools Kill Creativity?" was introduced by Co-Pres. **Nicole Whitenight**. In this 2006 TED talk, creativity expert Sir Kenneth Robinson makes a moving case for creating an education system that nurtures (rather than undermines) creativity. Some excerpts:

- My contention is [that] all kids have tremendous talents, and we squander them, pretty ruthlessly.
- What we do know is, if you're not prepared to be wrong, you'll never come up with anything original... [We have] national education systems where mistakes are the worst thing you can make.
- Every education system on earth has the same hierarchy of subjects... There isn't an education system on the planet that teaches dance every day to children the way we teach them mathematics. Why not?
- We know three things about intelligence. One, it's diverse... Secondly, intelligence is dynamic... intelligence is wonderfully interactive. The brain isn't divided into compartments... And the third thing about intelligence is, it's distinct.
- I believe our only hope for the future is to... start to reconstitute our conception of the richness of human capacity. Our education system has mined our minds in the way that we strip-mine the earth for a particular commodity. We have to rethink the fundamental principles on which we're educating our children.
