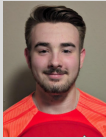

LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM

Paige Listen, LCSW, of SummitStone, gave us a great overview of the new *Longview Behavioral Health Center*. A few highlights: • The funding for the new facility comes from the 2018 sales tax bill passed by voters. • **Levels of Care:** 24x7 behavioral health urgent care; withdrawal management; a crisis stabilization unit; upcoming expanding bed capacity and opioid treatment services. • **Facts:** 75% of clients are voluntary | much valuable data is being gathered on an ongoing basis | length of stay (for medical reasons) has been extended to 7 days | this facility, it turns out, was desperately needed!
