Estate Planning 101



Jacqueline Zipser, a distinguished attorney, gave a comprehensive overview of essential things to remember in our estate planning, to protect our assets and ensure they go to whom we desire. Some highlights:

- One's will only covers certain assets (*probate property*).
- Be sure to name successors to your beneficiaries.
- If you get a divorce, you should re-title your assets.
- A *Living Will* won't ensure a *Do Not Resuscitate (DNR)* order; you must also have a *Medical Orders for Scope of Treatment (MOST)* signed by a doctor.
- Be careful not to name minors as direct beneficiaries, but rather you should set up trusts for them.
