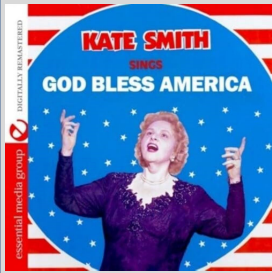

LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM

CSU's Athletic Director John Weber spoke on the Athletic program of Colorado State University. He opined that the Athletics at a university serve as the best marketing tool for the school. He spoke with pride in the academic achievements of these athletes in the university's sports programs had achieved. He estimated the value of reference to the university in all publications and broadcasts were valued at over 4 Billion dollars, with over 2 Billion of that directly attributable to the Athletic program. He spoke of the University's wish to become the most loved, most watched and most innovative institution in the US west.
