The scholarships are merit—and need-based. We award scholarships based on your application, essay, and interview quality. We are looking for students who are strong leaders and service-minded.

Scholarships consist of the following:

- The Rotary Student of the Month is open only to students who have received Student of the Month recognition.
- Pine Street Residential Trade/Vocational Scholarship
- The Phyllis Morey Memorial Scholarship is open to students who are at least 50% Hispanic.
- THREE Barbara and Mike Morey Trade Scholarships
- Rotary Non-Traditional Scholarship
- Rotary's FIVE Encouragement Scholarships are open to all students.

The Rotary Club of Teton Valley Local Foundation shall administer ALL scholarships and determine the recipients.

Criteria for

Pine Street Residential Scholarship

The Pine Street Residential Scholarship offers a scholarship to a student pursuing education at a trade school or vocational training program and will lead to employment in the student's chosen field. This includes associate degree programs or vocational/trade programs that result in employment opportunities without the need for further academic work. Examples of acceptable fields include paralegal studies, auto mechanics, aviation mechanics, medical technology, cosmetology, culinary arts, and other similar vocational paths.

- A minimum GPA of 2.5.
- Intended Educational Pursuit: The student's educational goals must be aligned with their chosen field of interest.
- Academic Achievement: Past academic performance will be considered.
- Community Service: Evidence of service or volunteer work.
- High Ethical Standards: Demonstration of strong moral principles and character.
- Extracurricular Activities: Participation in school or community activities will be considered.
- Submit two letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a Teton High School faculty member.

The Rotary Club of Teton Valley Local Foundation shall administer this scholarship and determine the recipients.

Criteria for

Phyllis Morey Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is only open to students with at least 50% Hispanic Heritage. It is a Four-year scholarship, paid out at \$3,000 per year.

GROWTH

We are interested in honoring students demonstrating personal growth in high school.

- Minimum GPA 3.0
- Submit two letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a Teton High School faculty member.

The Rotary Club of Teton Valley Local Foundation shall administer this scholarship and determine the recipients.

Criteria for

Barbara and Mike Morey Trade School Scholarship

There shall be three \$1,500 scholarships available to applicants attending a trade program or vocational training program at an Idaho community college of up to two years in duration.

The applicant must be awarded an Idaho Launch Scholarship.

The scholarship will be disbursed by the college at a rate of \$750 per semester to cover fees and expenses after the Idaho Launch funds have been applied. The scholarship may extend for up to two years if a student is enrolled in a multi-year program for a maximum of \$3,000.

- The applicant must have a 2.0 GPA
- Submit two letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a Teton High School faculty member.

The Rotary Club of Teton Valley Local Foundation shall administer this scholarship and determine the recipients.

Criteria for

Rotary Non-Traditional Scholarship

This is a \$1,500 scholarship available to applicants attending a trade program or vocational training program.

- A minimum GPA of 2.0
- Submit two letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a Teton High School faculty member.

The Rotary Club of Teton Valley Local Foundation shall administer this scholarship and determine the recipients.

Criteria for

Rotary Encouragement Scholarship

Five scholarships, each worth \$2,000, will be awarded. Whether you are pursuing a degree, certification or furthering your skills, we encourage you to apply and take advantage of this opportunity.

- A minimum GPA of 3.0
- Submit two letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a Teton High School faculty member.

The Rotary Club of Teton Valley Local Foundation shall administer this scholarship and determine the recipients.
