

2026 Teton Valley Rotary Scholarship Program

The Rotary Club of Teton Valley Local Foundation offers scholarships for Teton Valley high school seniors. Applications from home-schooled students living in Teton Valley will be considered. The scholarships are merit-based and need-based. Scholarships are awarded based upon an application, essay, resume, and interview.

Successful scholarship applicants are students who are service minded, have community service experience and possess strong leadership skills. Student applicants should possess good written and verbal communication skills and be able to explain the impact of their volunteer work, what need was addressed, articulate what was learned by volunteering. Also state what the volunteer experiences revealed about their strengths, values, and character. Strong and impactful written and verbal commentary should include specific examples, measurable impact if possible, and thoughtful reflection.

2026 Scholarships

1. The Rotary Student of the Month; available only to students who have received The Rotary Student of the Month award.
2. The Rotary Encouragement Scholarships: Five scholarships are available.
3. The Phyllis Morey Memorial Scholarship: available to students who have a minimum 50% Hispanic heritage.
4. The Barbara and Mike Morey Trade School scholarships: three scholarships are available.
5. The Cheryl Dorn Memorial Scholarship: available only to female students.

Note: The Rotary Club of Teton Valley Local Foundation shall administer all scholarship applications for all scholarship programs offered and determine the award recipients.

Value Amount for Scholarships

Rotary Student of the Month-

\$5,000

(The student must have been previously selected as The Rotary Student of the Month to apply. Please see the criteria below).

Rotary Encouragement Scholarships-

\$2,000

(Five scholarships are available, each worth \$2,000. We encourage students to apply who wish to pursue a degree, a certification or further their skills to apply).

Phyllis Morey Memorial Scholarship-

\$12,000

(Available only to students who have a minimum 50% Hispanic heritage. This is a 4-year scholarship that will be funded at \$3,000 annually).

Barbara and Mike Morey Trade School Scholarship-

\$1,500

(Three scholarships are available for \$1,500 each. Please see criteria below).

Cheryl Dorn Memorial Scholarship-
\$2,500

(Available to a female student. Please see criteria below).

Scholarship Criteria

Rotary Student of the Month-

Teton Valley Rotary is seeking students who are strong leaders who are service minded and have community service experience. This scholarship is offered because Rotarians encourage others to live by the Rotary 4-Way Test. The successful applicant will have demonstrated the qualities and values of the 4-Way Test.

The Rotary 4-Way Test

1. Is it the truth?
2. Is it fair to all concerned?
3. Will it build goodwill and better friendships?
4. Will it be beneficial to all concerned?

- Minimum GPA of 3.5
- 3.0+ GPA will be considered if a student is enrolled in academically challenging classes.

- Successful applicants are students who have achieved personal growth, who volunteer in school and our community, engage in helping classmates and underclassmen.

Only students previously selected as Rotary Student of the Month are eligible to apply for this \$5,000 scholarship.

Rotary Encouragement Scholarships-

Five scholarships, each worth \$2,000, are available to those to pursue a degree, a certification or skill enhancement program.

- Minimum GPA of 3.0
- Two letters of recommendation required, one must be from a high school faculty member.

Phyllis Morey Memorial Scholarship-

This scholarship is only available to students who have a minimum of 50% Hispanic heritage. The scholarship will be funded at \$3,000 per year for 4 years.

- Minimum GPA of 3.0
- Two letters of recommendation are required; one must be from a high school faculty member.

Barbara and Mike Morey Trade School Scholarships-

Three scholarships for \$1,500 each are available to students who will attend a trade school or vocational training program at an Idaho community college for up to two years. The scholarship will be funded at \$750 per semester for the first year and may be extended for one additional year if the student is enrolled in multi-year program for a maximum of \$3,000.

- Minimum GPA of 2.0
- Two letters of recommendation are required; one must be from a high school faculty member.

Cheryl Dorn Memorial Scholarship-

This scholarship is only available to a female student who must pursue an education in any business-related field of study at a two- or four-year college or university.

- Minimum GPA of 3.0
- Two letters of recommendation are required; one must be from a high school faculty member.

10. Prepare and submit your resume to include: academic accomplishments, GPA, work experience, community volunteering/service work, school activities, and involvement.
11. Provide an estimate of school expenses to include: tuition, room and board, books/supplies, and any other school related expenses.
12. Indicate any other scholarships you have received.
