We believe education assures an individual and their family the best quality of life and opportunity to live up to one's true potential. SW Rotarians also support Women and Children, ensuring families can address basic needs. Fellowship with others who share a belief in Service Above Self helps Rotarians invest in our communities while improving the opportunities for health, safety, and the wellbeing of those around all of us.

- Examples of our Education focused funding include Lunches & Teacher funding for Road to College's MSU Summer Camp, Wichita Falls Youth Symphony Orchestra funding (providing expert 1:1 instruction at no charge to student), Big Brothers / Big Sisters (connecting kids with mentoring adults), Fain Elementary's STEM program
- Our support for Women & Children helps to ease the communities needs to address basic family unit needs. We provide funds to non-profits like these: Boy Scouts, Food Banks in Clay & Wichita Counties, MSU's Mustang Food Pantry, Meals on Wheels (Clay & Wichita County), Project Back to School (Backpacks with school supplies), North Texas Area United Way (funding for VITA tax preparation - providing 3,000 people with over \$7M of funds through help with the tax preparation and submission).
- Community Projects improving our community:
  - Dec 2020, Wichita Falls Police department new K-9 Officer
  - Spring 2021, County Rotary Clubs worked with County and City government promoting healthy practices vs COVID.
  - Honoring the ENJET program at SAFB working with the other Rotary clubs to repair and install new flags at the Rotary Plaza by MPEC.
  - New Playground equipment funded by three Wichita Falls Rotary clubs for Rotary Park (by Boys & Girls & Cunningham Elementary).
