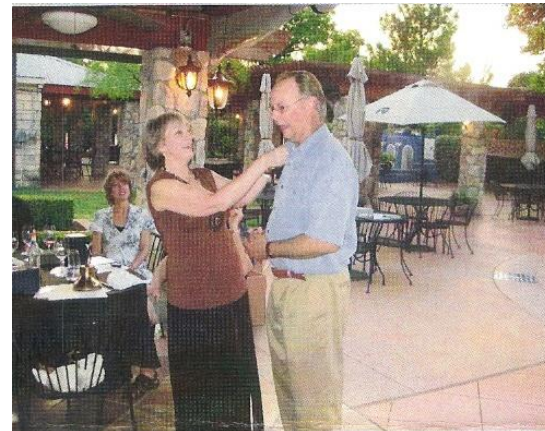

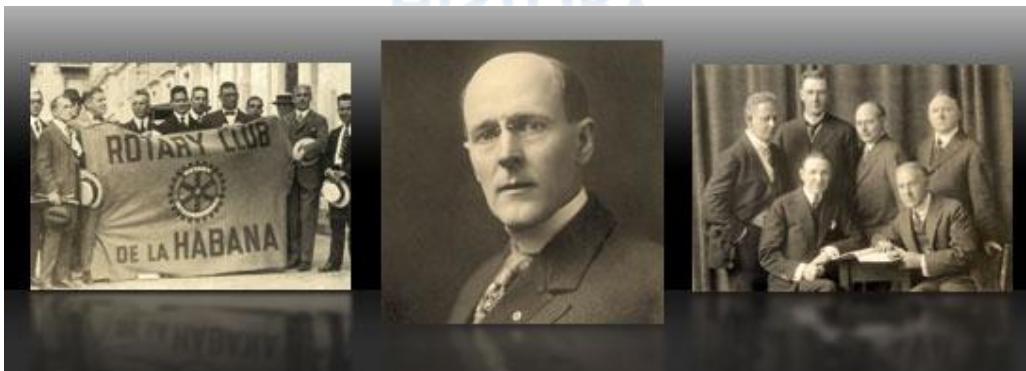

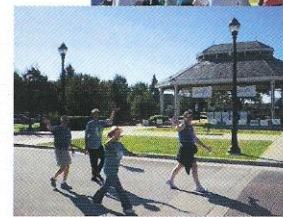

Interact is Rotary International's service club for young people ages **14 to 18**. Interact clubs are sponsored by individual Rotary clubs, which provide support and guidance



Rotaract is a Rotary-sponsored service club for young men and women ages **18 to 30**. Rotaract clubs are either community or university based, and they're sponsored by a local Rotary club. 7,000 clubs in about 163 countries



Rotary Youth Leadership Awards (RYLA) is Rotary's leadership training program for young people ages **14-18**

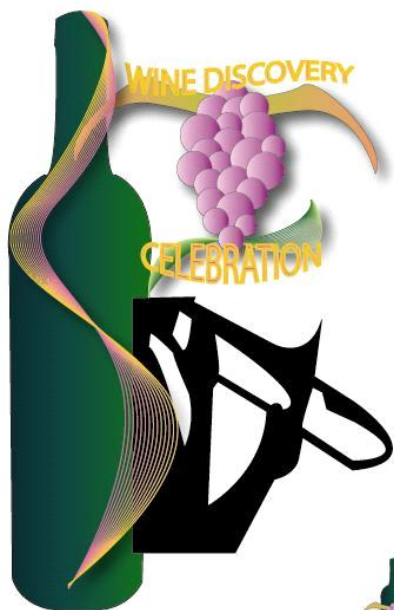
