DISTRICT GOVERNORS VISIT

9820 District Governor, Janne Speirs, spoke during her club visit to The Rotary Club of Bairnsdale, opening with deference to International President, Barry Rassin. He is a fine speaker and a inspiring example to all Rotarians.

Janne is passionate about Rotary marketing itself in the community, not because we want kudos, but because the public will automatically get to know us through our image, the Rotary Wheel as well as the name, Rotary. We need to celebrate what we do because people need to know. Polio eradication is not known to be the huge project which Rotary has been involved with for many years. If we market well, we can attract new members. Barry Rassin has asked us to have Rotary Days in all sorts of different areas, so people can see the enjoyment and enthusiasm with which we approach our Rotary involvement.

Membership has been an issue for a while, but Janne believes we can turn it around. We must. We need to be excited about what we do. Janne's membership goal for this year is 1500 members in District 9820. If we average 3-4 new members in each club, and not lose any, this goal can be realised. But these new members must be quality people who are interested in joining us.

One thing for our club to do is club visioning. On October 13th we have been invited to attend a one day seminar in Berwick to work on club membership. Details will be given later.

Another goal for our club is to donate \$100 per member over and above individual giving such as the Centurion program. Our club could decide an amount to give to Foundation and in three years time the District will get back 50% of what was originally given. For example, if the District donation is \$150,000, then in three years the District would receive back from Foundation, \$75,000 to do with what is decided. There is not another charity on the world which does that.

Janne talked about the polio eradication program which must continue if the world is to be rid of this disease for ever. Withdrawing now would mean outbreaks all over the world and all the work Rotary has done would be undone. Bill Gates has promised another \$300,000,000 over three years and Rotarians will donate \$150,000,000. We must win this war against polio since we are so close to complete success.

On February 15th to 27th the multi district conference will be held in Melbourne. It promises to be an event not to be missed. Will we see you there? Yes, we hope so.
