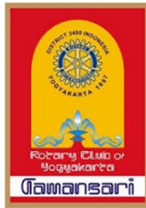
This camp was so worthwhile for me and I thank Rotary not only for this opportunity but for many previous ones, and hopefully more opportunities to come.
