


Last week we had Sally Dell, the District 9820 Champion for End Trachoma 2020, an initiative started in 2017-2018 by Past RI President Ian Riseley who felt that this totally preventable disease could be eradicated from Australia, the only developed country that still has recorded cases, amongst our indigenous community.

#### What is Trachoma?

Trachoma is the world's leading cause of infectious blindness. Some may know it as Sandy Blight, it is a contagious bacterial infection, caused by the bacterium Chlamydia Trachomatis. It is completely preventable however with repeated infection, it can cause scarring inside the eyelids which causes the eyelashes to turn in, leading to painful scratching of the eye on every blink, which can then lead to irreversible blindness. Trachoma spreads by personal contact (via hands, clothing, towels or bedding), or by flies in contact with infected discharge from the nose or eves of children's faces. Women seem to suffer much more frequently and severely than men as they are the carers of young children.

In April 2016, Lien Trinh who is our End Trachoma Project Manager, attended the World Health Organisation (WHO) 'Global Elimination of Trachoma by 2020' meeting on behalf of Rotary to meet with all the Status of elimination of trachoma as a public health problem, 2018



Australian Stakeholders to learn about Trachoma in Australia and to decide if we should become involved. Lien studied for a Master's of Public Health at the London School of Tropical Medicine as a Rotary Scholar Foundation Global in 2013/14. She is an optometrist and expert in public health. Sally explained that using good hygiene, such as careful washing of hands, blowing noses and keeping the face clean, bacteria will have a hard job of taking control. With this in mind using funds raised to buy simple things like a personal face washer, not to be shared with others and ensuring reliable clean water. It is not a good statistic when you realise that Australia is the only developed country that still has cases, but with the help of the World

Health Organisation, the Australian Government and Rotary we hope that it can be eliminated soon.

Sally together with DG Janne attended a conference in Alice Springs and were able to see firsthand what is happening in the Aboriginal communities and how education is being delivered to improve the hygiene for those living in basic conditions. Janne spoke briefly about it when she visited recently and was obviously very impressed by what she saw, as was Sally and both seem to have fallen in love with Alice Springs.

Thank you to Sally and her husband Peter who made the trip from Warragul to talk to us, although Sally has said she is willing to travel anywhere to promote the cause.
