

Sunrise Membership Responsibilities

- Club dues payable every 6 months – \$110 every June & December
- Rotary Registration of Volunteer form (Form 7) to be completed – see Club Protection Officer
- Working with Children card to be held - see Club Protection Officer
- Attendance at weekly breakfast meetings:
 - If you are unable to attend, apologies to be given, emailed or messaged to the Social Director by close of business Tuesday pm.
 - Guests are welcome but please respect our hosts at Bairnsdale International by informing the Social Director as above.
 - Fees for breakfast are:

Fees are pay on the day or online, (please add note to specify breakfast with online payment).
 - You will be put on a roster for various jobs at the meeting e.g. Invocation, Vote of thanks or chairing the meeting.
The roster is printed in the bulletin and you are responsible for finding a replacement if you cannot attend, and informing the secretary of the change.
- Social nights :
 - These are usually held in the last week in the month.
There is no formal part to the social meeting and guests are most welcome.
 - Unlike the breakfast meetings, a list is normally circulated and members should indicate if they, and any guests will attend.
 - Cost for social nights vary and are paid on the night.
- Howitt Park Market:
 - This is our ongoing fundraising effort. The market is held on the fourth Sunday of each month at Howitt park.
All members are rostered on at least 4 times per year and everyone is expected to support this.
 - If you need to change your rostered place please find a replacement and let the Market Director know.
 - The assistant Market Manager role is shared among members, month by month. It involves liaising with the Market Director and the Market Co-Ordinator, and being responsible for the money collected.
- Every member is assigned a position on a committee. These positions can be changed each year when our board changes over mid-year. It is the responsibility of each member to support their committee in new and ongoing
