### This Week's Program – Anita Hermans

Anita is a registered psychologist with AHPRA and an Associate Member of the Australian Psychological Society.

Anita was educated at Drouin Secondary College from 1992 and graduated in 1997.

From 1998 – 2000 Anita completed a Bachelor of Applied Science in Psychology at Deakin University in Burwood.

In 2001, she completed a Graduate Diploma of Psychology, also at Deakin University and in 2005 completed a Graduate Diploma in Adolescent Health and Welfare through The University of Melbourne.

During her 20 years of practice she has been in a variety of roles from training project work and counselling.

Her main area of counselling is with 2–25-year old's,

Her clients are referred by parents and carers, kindergartens and schools, community-based organisations, general practitioners, paediatricians and psychiatrists. The majority of this work is subsidised by Medicare.

This year marks her 20th year in practice.

Currently she works out of the Warragul north consulting suites where she manages a “huge” business team of technology staff (her husband) and bookkeeper (her dad).

During her presentation she mentioned the concept of adolescence which research suggests continues up of 25 when the brain is fully developed.

Think of the decisions society requires people to make before their brains are fully developed.

In the last 6 years Anita has had a total of 300 clients from kindergarten to adulthood, more females than males; from all types of schools, and types of employment.

Clients are referred for reasons such as sexual assault or abuse, drug or alcohol problems, eating disorders, schizophrenia, bipolar disorder, depression and anxiety.

The Covid pandemic has also added to the incidence referrals and the full impact of Covid and the mental of young people is still be identified.

The following slide was a great illustration of how widespread disruption to young people's lives has been.

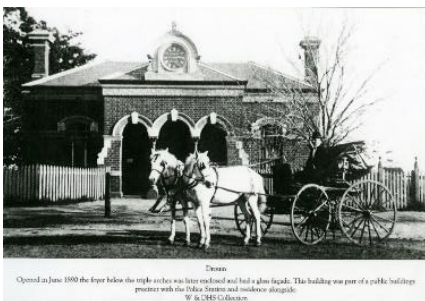
