




Pie Night

This project was headed by Past President, Leigh Bates, assisted by several other Rotarians.

I just wanted to pass on my Thanks on behalf of Parks Victoria for the recent Project in the

Labertouche Caves Reserve in conjunction with the Drouin Rotary Club.

I was impressed by the Students initiative to support the Project in early phase and involving the experienced crew from the Drouin Rotary Club. The Team worked exceptionally well together.

There was a total of 126 Volunteer hours contributed for the result which not only worked on replacing rotted steps with new rock ones but was able to repair other steps in the area, add traction to slippery steps and remove a lot of fencing wire and posts which have become obsolete.

Another highlight was the lunches Leigh provided from Rotary Club of Drouin, which added value and some great conversations to our work experience.
