A cracking good read.

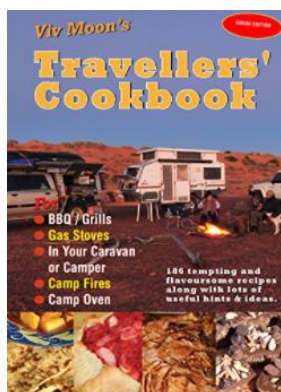
### **Rob Stewart**

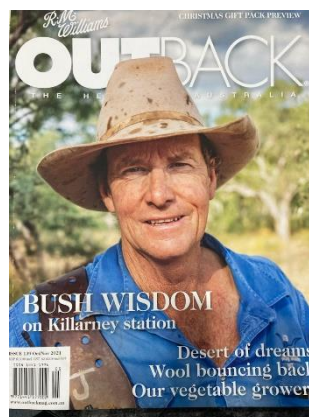

to arrive to check out places I have been and more importantly places I need to visit

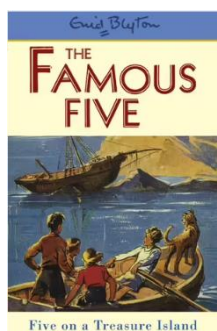
### Rob Coustley

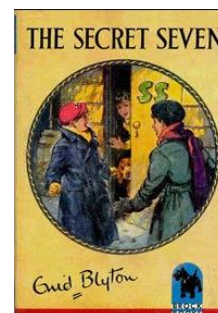
