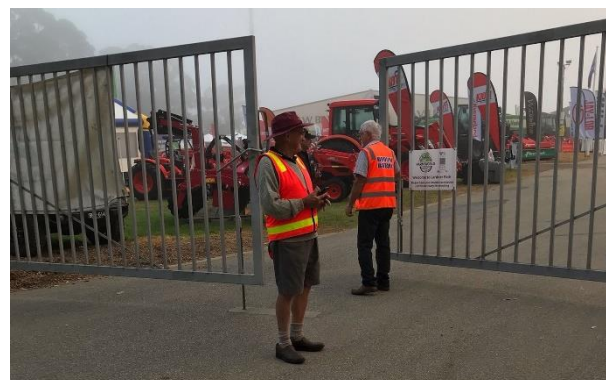
Office Bearers Desperately Needed:
