## EN PLEIN AIR LANDSCAPE PAINTING COMPETITION

### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY and RULES of the COMPETITION

- Completed entry forms and entry fees must be received **by 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2023**
- Open to all artists over 18 years.
- Artists are to supply all their own equipment for OPEN AIR painting. No digital artwork or digital enhancement will be accepted. Artists should make their own provision for sun protection PPE and inclement weather.
- Artists will have 4 hours to complete a landscape/ seascape /townscape.
- Artists **must register** at the Mechanics Hall located at 18, Mechanics Street. Lakes Entrance between **10.00am** and **Noon** on Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> Mar 2023 and have their blank working canvas, paper or other substrate stamped, numbered and a start and finish time allocated. Artists can have a wash applied to their canvas but no grid or drawing. An additional 15 minutes will be allowed each way to get to and from their set up position and the Mechanics Hall. The Club will assist with transport if required. Artists may submit more than one piece for no additional entry fee provided each canvas has been certified and numbered.
- Artists can choose any waterfront location between the Floating Dragon Restaurant and the Footbridge to set up for their landscape painting on the **grassed areas** rather than on the boardwalk and concrete footpath to avoid pedestrians, skateboards and bicycles.
- Completed artworks must be returned to the Mechanics Hall by the allocated time (i.e., 4 hours 30 minutes after their registered time) and by 4.30pm for artists who have registered at 12 noon at the latest. Judging will take place between 4.30pm and 6.30 pm and prize winners announced and paid at 12 noon on Sunday.
- Artists will be served afternoon tea and refreshments from 4.30pm.
- Artists can enter their completed artwork for sale on Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> Mar 23 in the Mechanics Hall. The Rotary Club will take 20% commission on the nominated sale price. The Club will take no responsibility for any loss or damage to the artwork however they will exercise due care in overseeing the artwork.
- Each artist may submit one previously painted additional original work for display and sale, along with their landscape completed on Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> Mar 23. This work should clearly identify the artist, title, and phone number on the rear. This can be handed in at the time of registration. The Rotary Club will take 20% commission on the nominated sale price.
- Unsold artwork should be collected by the artists after 4pm on Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> Mar 23. We will not be responsible for artworks left behind.
- Payments to artist for sales proceeds will be forwarded within 30 days .
