The first course will start at 5:45PM.

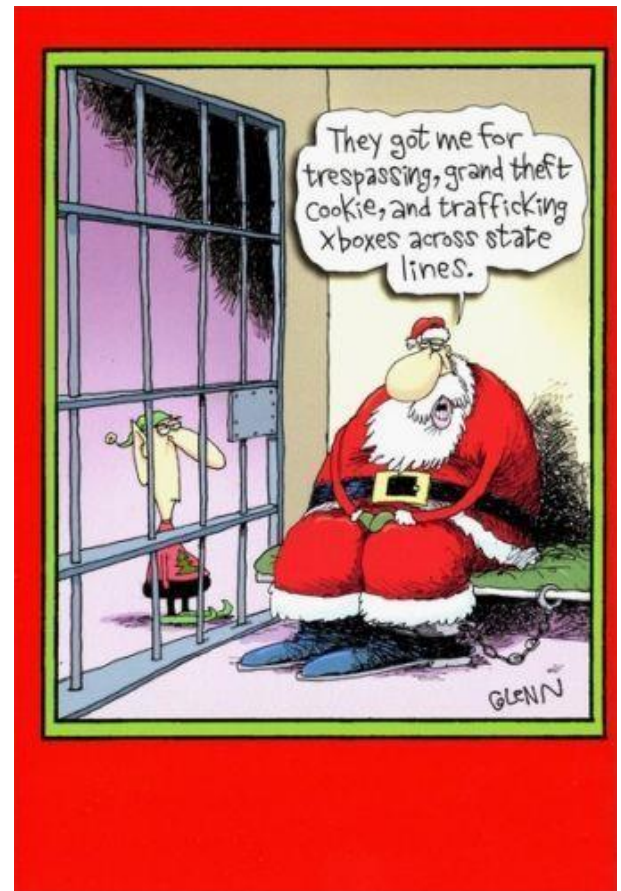
All guests intending to contribute to the meals, should please contact Paula first, and she will coordinate with the Hurleys and the Goodlucks.
