WORST YEARS EVER: 536CE

If you thought 2023 and the previous few years have been bad with wars, pandemic, weather catastrophes and political instability, lets go back to 536 CE and the following years.

It started well for the Emperor Justinian of the Eastern Roman Empire (Byzantine). He had reconquered the western parts of the Empire including Rome and would win the Gothic War. However, volcanic eruptions led to the devastation of crops and worldwide hunger. Then followed the bubonic plague in 541 which caused the deaths of up to one half of the population of the Eastern Roman Empire. After this came a period when the Byzantines found themselves fighting a two front war in the East and in the West against Tribes who were seeking fertile lands most likely because of failed agricultural results at home.
