MICHAEL KELSON



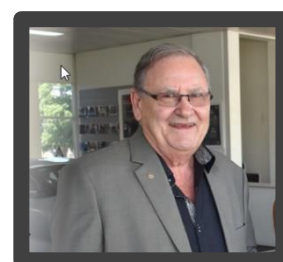
I start this Bulletin by noting, with great sadness, the passing of Rotarian, and fellow Club member, Michael Kelson.
