Timor- Leste Australia's neighbour is one of the poorest (and newest) countries in the world. The project constructed a three cubical toilet block with wash basins in the remote village of Manlala situated in Timor-Leste's Soibada district. Prior to the project the Manlala community lacked adequate toilet facilities.

The toilet block was be built adjacent to the school so that school children have access to the block during school times. The toilet block was completed by 1st April 2024
