Sandy and Irene gave us an insight into holidaying on canals in Europe. The canals were originally built for transport of goods throughout the countries in the1600s. Today you can cruise from Holland through Belgium and around France as they have done over the past 13 years.

To get from Holland to France you must go through 84 locks. this just shows what a great bit of engineering it was in the 1600s. Today the canals are called the long village.

Outside gas heaters and BBQs must not be used indoors as they give off carbon monoxide, which is odourless, colourless and can kill you.

Indoor gas heaters need checking every 2 years by a licenced gas fitter to make sure that they don't start giving off carbon monoxide fumes. Remember all heaters be it gas, electric or wood should be at least a metre away from clothes and clothes racks.
