I was able to brief the Club on the outcome of our Board meeting. In particular, the Board reviewed our finances and determined that we could increase the level of donations intended for:


- Lakes Entrance Neighbourhood House

There is a good possibility that they have breathed in carbon monoxide from the BBQ or gas heater. So, take care around all gas appliances and ensure you regularly check gas hoses and connections.
