Thanks to all members who attended our meeting last Wednesday to hear Marion Dawson giving an excellent presentation on Landcare – “It’s not just about planting trees”. Marion will be known to many members and has been a longtime dedicated volunteer in East Gippsland Landcare Network in addition to her involvement with Bairnsdale Inner Wheel, Friends of Nyrnilang Heritage Park, and Bairnsdale Art Gallery.

This busy lady gave up her evening to come along and tell us all about Landcare which is now established in 20 countries. Landcare is now one of the largest environmental volunteer organisations in Victoria encouraging “hands on” community led action.

So it’s not just about planting trees, there is the eradication of feral animals, including deer rabbits and foxes, building safe fishing access platforms, farmland improvement, running workshops, working with schools, maintaining the Rail Trail and getting involved with Clean Up Australia Day held on the first Sunday in March each year. They have also done a lot of work eradicating weeds and have developed the Wallaby Creek walking track at Tambo Bluff. Marion said their greatest need is for “hands-on” volunteers. I have her phone number!

BUNNINGS I have had a response from Bunnings regarding our request for a sausage sizzle slot. Currently they are booked up to the end of September but we should get a couple of slots in October November and December. They will be in touch with us before then with the documentation and will invite members to participate in an induction session. We don’t need to have a food handling certificate.
