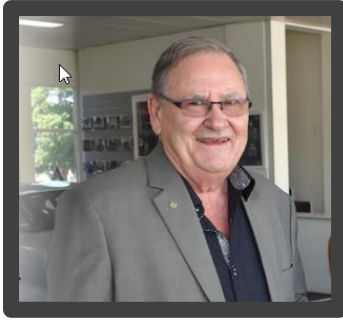

Hello All



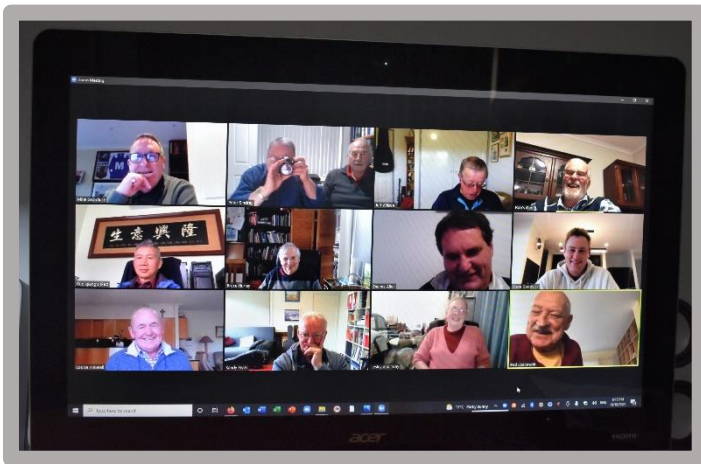
We had lots of activity tonight, with a Board Meeting followed by a brief Club Assembly – and all conducted via Zoom.
