WHAT'S ON IN THE CLUSTER

Recently we invited the Presidents of the Clubs in our Cluster, to a meeting to talk about joint activities.

We agreed it would be great to have a Cluster Christmas function again this year. We are now looking to identify a venue to house the event.

In addition, we discussed the prospect of a joint Cluster-wide function to raise funds for great Rotary projects.

We will talk further as progress in made.

We also discussed the prospect of Cluster-wide support for some projects already underway:

 We will look to expand interest in our Timor Leste program by presenting to other Clubs in Bairnsdale. Our most recent briefing from Timor Leste includes confirmation of completed works achieved by the support of Australian Rotary Clubs. In the east, 62 Galvanized 5,500 Litre Water Tanks have now been installed and 7 three cubicle School Toilets have now been constructed.




- A Sunrise request to donate to funds for a young lady to travel to US, to undertake further University studies on ways to improve basic healthcare treatment and prevent illness and disease. Sunrise is seeking funds under the Rotary Global Scholarship scheme. Our Club funds are scarce at this time of year and further consideration may follow later. In the meantime, a donation of \$200 has been approved by our Board.
- A Sunrise request in support of a conference of Rural and Regional Community
 Health authorities, including GLCH. The conference in October, is aimed at
 initiatives to improve Government support for health services in areas beyond
 the Melbourne metropolitan area. Again, our available funds are limited at
 this time of year. The Board has approved a donation of \$200.
