PRESIDENT SANDY'S SNIPPETS

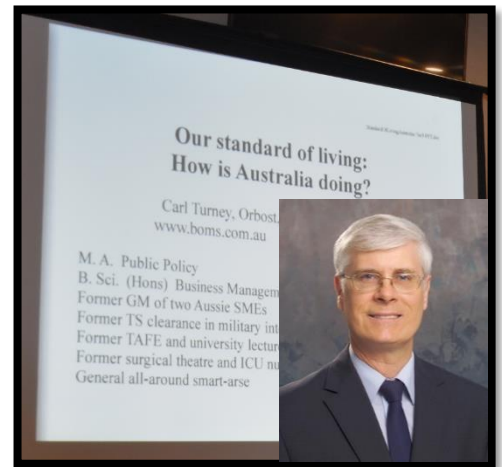


Reports from abroad indicate our President is enjoying his holiday in Europe. Last known, he and Irene were in France during a heat wave, with forecasts of storms on the way.
