The Expo will be held on **Sunday 6**<sup>th</sup> **October from 10am till 2pm** and will be held at the Mechanics Hall, Lakes Entrance.

The Lakes Entrance Lions Club will hold a free Sausage Sizzle (waiting on grant approval) which should attract attention.

The hall will be open from 8am, giving you 2 hours set up time before opening to the public at 10am.



Fire blankets should be in all kitchen and cooking areas and readily available if required.

When required, pull the tabs and the blanket will come out of its jacket and open out so you can place it over a stove fire. Do it gently and aim to cover the pan fire.

Then turn off the electricity or gas.

If not comfortable with the situation, call the fire brigade. Fire Blankets are only \$15 to \$20 each at hardware stores and are required to meet specific Australian Standards before they can be sold to the Public.
