OUR SPEAKER TONIGHT







Our guest tonight was two-time Olympian Aislin Jones who told us about her journey to reach the Paris Olympics, competing in the Skeet shooting event, first as a solo shooter and, later, in the mixed event.

Until 2024, Aislin's extensive experience included being a seven-times National Women's Champion in Skeet shooting. She also represented Australia at the Rio Olympics in 2016 and in the 2018 Gold Coast Commonwealth Games.

And now, we heard from this inspiring lady about her experiences during the Paris Olympics. She shared her story about the complex and arduous processes she followed to qualify for the Olympics and the emotions she experienced when representing her country at an Olympic Games.



Aislin has longer term ambitions to continue her career in Skeet shooting at the 2028 Los Angeles Olympics and the 2032 Olympics (yet to be located). We leave the evening full of confidence to believe she will continue to succeed as an international athlete.

We were keen to hear from Aislin, a Lakes Entrance lady, as our Club contributed towards the funding necessary for her to compete in Paris. Years earlier, our Club also helped her when she travelled to the 2016 Olympics in Rio. In 2016 she addressed the Club, expressing her appreciation. Again tonight, Aislin thanked the Lakes Rotary Club for our support.

We will watch her progress with great interest, confident that we will see her visit our Club again.

DO YOU HAVE A FIRE PLAN ??

We all hope we will not need one, but it is better to have a comprehensive fire plan in place, just in case it is needed. If you have bad fires near you, remember hot ash can travel up to 10-15 kms and start spot fires.



In these circumstances you cannot always expect a fire truck to arrive at the last minute because, on many occasions, demands for help by lots of people will mean that emergency services are stretched to the limit.



And make sure your driveway is 'fire truck friendly'. For a fire truck to get to your home it will need a 4m clearance, both width and height, for the fire vehicle to gain access.
