Thanks to Peter Sindrey for organising it, and to all our members who helped with the sale of the tickets which added a substantial sum to our funds for this year.

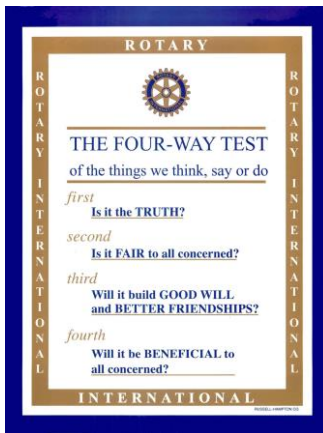
Community Exposition
