# PETE'S PRATTLE



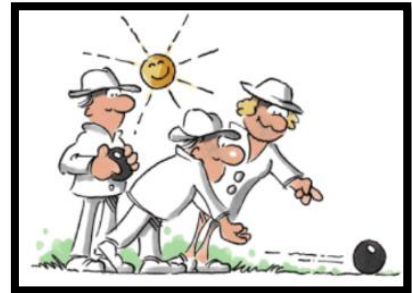
Hello All. We are fast approaching the end of the current Rotary year, with our own Changeover function scheduled for Wednesday 29 June 2022.

We will hear from Paul about his vision for the 2022 / 2023 Rotary year and some details about his District Conference next February.

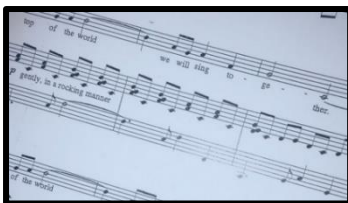
