A Lasting Reminder of our Work





TRF Funds

- The Annual Fund
 50% to World Fund
 50% we get back as District
 Designated Funds (DDF)
- Polio Plus
- Endowed (Permanent) Fund





After 3 years:

50% of Annual Fund Donations are returned to the District to be used for Club projects (DDF).

50% of Annual Fund Donations go into the World Fund



DDF available to 5950 Clubs

2015-16 \$320,000

2016-17 \$331,000

2017-18 \$390,000

2018-19 \$380,000






DDF (District Designated Funds)

(The half our district gets back) is divided into:

- 50% Global Grants Large International
- 50% District Grants Local and Small International projects







The leverage achieved via global grants

- Clubs put in \$10,000 for a project
- District matches 1:1 with DDF =\$10,000 more
- Global fund matches DDF 1:1 & club funds .5:1
 =\$15,000 more
- Total project = \$35,000!


