

There are approximately 45.6 Million People according to the Crime Global Slave Index which was setup to highlight the numbers caught up in human trafficking. The three areas are Labour, Sex Workers and Marriage 71% female and 29% Male. Currently there are approximately 15 thousand in Australia, Rural and Regional.


