



They were from District 1020 in Scotland and came to D9810 for 6 weeks to experience their vocations in Australia. This was called a Group Study Exchange. Later, a team went from D9810 to D1020. RC Wandin hosted the Scots during the last week of their stay, and their final presentation to our Club was a most memorable night. Team leader,

Like Gavan, Vic loves fishing and has a great sense of humour. Vic presented Gavan with a Quaich, a Scottish Friendship Cup, as well as his vest, bow tie and tie. Some ties were also donated by the team members and were auctioned for Rotary fundraising.

These garments are made from a unique tartan created and made especially for the team, in Vic's home town of Selkirk. The tartan was named the Millenium Tartan and only exists in these garments. At the end of his year, Gavan decided to hand on the vest and bow tie to the incoming president. And so the custom continues 23 years on, as does our friendship with Vic and Hazel in Scotland. Over the years we have had the pleasure in hosting them on 2 further trips to Australia and visiting them in Scotland several times, including one trip with Heinz and Marie. 
