Once you are inducted as a Member, complete your My Rotary profile and your member information in *Club Runner*. Here's how:

- 1. Go to https://my.rotary.org
- 2. Select Register for an Account. You will need your Rotary ID number.
- 3. Go to http://www.bangorrotary.org Select Member Login in upper right corner.
- 4. Enter your user name in this format: First.Last Your password is: Last1234
- 5. After you log in, select **Member Area** in the upper right corner.
- 6. Select Edit my Profile from the My ClubRunner menu. Change your password and update your info.
- 7. Edit your information and Save. Voila! You're done!

Attend a meeting of the Club's board of directors. The board of directors meets every first Tuesday of the month at 1pm following our regular club meeting.

**Serve as a Greeter or work at the Front Desk**. Greeters should arrive by 11:45 am. Front desk workers should arrive by 11:30am. Pick up a "Greeter" badge at the Front Desk. Contact a Membership Committee co-chair to schedule your work shift.

*Give a Classification Talk at a regular club meeting*. Tell the club about yourself and your vocation. Speak with our Program Chair or any monthly program coordinator to schedule your talk. Guidelines for giving a classification talk are located on our club website.

*Visit another Rotary club*. To really experience Rotary requires that you step outside the comfort zone of the local club and meet some other Rotarians in neighboring areas. Invite another club member or members to join you on your visit. Visit other clubs in our Zone, our District, or in another country!

**Join a committee.** There is no shortage of ways to get involved. Committees focus on international projects, local service projects, fundraising, club and program administration, membership, and youth services. Share with your Sponsor and Membership Chair how you would like to get involved.

**Attend a Rotary Fellowship Event.** Attend a fellowship event so that members can get to know you.
