The Stillwater Frontier Rotary Club Young Professionals Program (YPP) has been adopted by the Stillwater Frontier Rotary Club to promote membership of young professionals under the age of 40. New members under the age of 40 have the option to apply to participate in this YPP Program. Once a YPP participant turns 40, eligibility ends on the anniversary date of the member's entry into the program.

Dues and Fees

- Dues are currently \$6.00/week (\$4 for dues, and \$2 for sustaining Paul Harris). Monthly dues will vary depending on how many weeks there are in that month as seen in the table below.
- The meal fee is currently \$14.00 per meal.

4 th Year	\$24/4 wk or \$30/5 wk	3 / month (\$42)	\$66.00 or \$72.00
5 th Year (Final year)	\$24/4 wk or \$30/5 wk	4 / month (\$56)	\$80.00 or \$86.00

- In line with Rotary's fiscal year, July 1 is the beginning of the year for all participants in the YPP.
 - If the member joins in the first half of the fiscal year (July-December), the member will move to the next level (2nd year) in the program on July 1 of the following calendar year.
 - If the member joins in the second half of the fiscal year (January - June), the member will move to the next level (2nd year) on January 1 of the next calendar year.
- YPP participants will not be fined during meetings by the Sergeant at Arms
- Dues and fees are subject to changes by the Club / Club Board.
- If a YPP participant's employer offers to pay dues and fees for civic organizations, full dues and fees as paid by non-YPP members are to be paid.

Requirements and Expectations:

- Attend all meetings. Absences happen, but efforts should be made to come to meetings and get to know the other members. If a YPP participant has 3 unexcused absences within the first three months, participation in the YPP ends and the member must reapply for the YPP Program.
- Actively participate in community service projects (at least 2 every 6 months) or serve on the Club Board. Activities may include, for example, delivering Mobile Meals on a regular basis, participating in reading at a school, helping with parking for SHS Football Games, or volunteering to ring the bell during the Christmas season.
